## **Runway at John C. Tune Airport to Close Temporarily for Rehabilitation**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — The runway at John C. Tune Airport (JWN) will be closed for rehabilitation, or repaving, beginning Monday, July 21, and may be closed for up to three weeks. No takeoffs or landings will be permitted during the closure period. The airport and many on-site operations, such as helicopter companies, will remain open during the runway closure. The airport is making alternate arrangements for tenants and other customers affected by the closure.

Located in West Nashville in the Cockrill Bend area, JWN is one of the busiest general aviation airports in Tennessee. Owned and managed by the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority, JWN serves the needs of regional corporate and private aircraft owners and operators. The airport is named in honor of the late John C. Tune – a Nashville attorney, civic leader, long-time aviation enthusiast and one of the principal developers of the modern aviation authority concept.
