Runway Closure at John C. Tune Airport Rescheduled for Sept. 3 Due to Weather

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — The John C. Tune Airport runway closure originally planned for selected hours Aug. 25 through Aug. 27 has been rescheduled for Sept. 3 due to weather. The runway at John C. Tune Airport (JWN) will be closed from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday, Aug. 28, to complete painting after being recently repaved. No takeoffs or landings will be permitted during the closure period. The airport and many on-site operations, such as helicopter companies, will remain open during the runway closure.

Located in West Nashville in the Cockrill Bend area, JWN is one of the busiest general aviation airports in Tennessee. Owned and managed by the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority, JWN serves the needs of regional corporate and private aircraft owners and operators. The airport is named in honor of the late John C. Tune — a Nashville attorney, civic leader, long-time aviation enthusiast and one of the principal developers of the modern aviation authority concept.
