## **Construction Complete on Additional Hangar at John C. Tune Airport**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Construction is now complete on Hangar 2 at John C. Tune Airport (JWN) in West Nashville. The new 18,000-square-foot facility can accommodate up to 10 large aircraft. The facility is located between Hangars 1 and 3.

Corporate Flight Management (CFM), based in Smyrna, Tenn., began construction on the aircraft storage facility in May 2007. Construction of the hangar was required in their 22-year lease agreement established in 2005.

With the addition of Hangar 2, JWN now has two large hangars for common use and 121 T-hangars for individual use. Hangar 1 is used for maintenance.

CFM has been providing general fixed base operator services at JWN since assuming the original lease of Tune Aviation Corporation in June of 1991.
