## **Construction Complete on New Ramp at John C. Tune Airport**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Construction is now complete on a new ramp at John C. Tune Airport (JWN) in West Nashville. The new ramp provides space for 29 new aircraft tie-downs and also serves as the new location for the self-service fueling area.

“We’re excited to further expand our capacity at John C. Tune Airport,” said Raul Regalado, president and CEO of the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority (MNA). “JWN is an asset to the region’s economic development efforts and to the general aviation community of the Nashville and middle Tennessee area. The new ramp space will allow us to accommodate even more customers to fulfill their aviation requirements.”

The new ramp and self-service fueling area are available for use by all customers of JWN, including the approximately 150 based customers.

This project added 200,700 square feet of asphalt adjacent to the terminal building and Taxiways A-2 and R-3, which created the additional aircraft parking spaces. This new space will be sufficient to provide additional parking for transient aircraft and those based aircraft not stored in hangars.

JWN is a general aviation airport located in West Nashville in the Cockrill Bend area. It serves the needs of regional corporate and private aircraft and is owned and managed by the MNA.
